ORDINANCE NO. 2007-001
TOWN OF PINE ISLAND, TEXAS

ADOPTING A SPEED LIMIT ON PIERCEALL ROAD OF THE TOWN OF PINE ISLAND; ESTABLISHING SAID SPEED LIMIT AT 30 MPH FOR AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF PINE ISLAND, TEXAS FOR THE SAFETY OF ALL CITIZENS IN THE TOWN OF PINE ISLAND AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF SAID ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PINE ISLAND, TEXAS:

No person shall drive a motor vehicle upon Pierceall Road within the city limits of Pine Island at a speed greater than thirty (30) miles per hour. The authority of the city to establish prima facie speed limits is granted in the Texas Transportation Code Chapter 545. Waller County Road and Bridge Department will place the signs indicating the 30 mph speed limit. Such signs will be in conformity with the Uniform Traffic Safety Code.


From and after the passing of this Ordinance it shall be lawful and mandatory upon the Waller County Sheriff's Department, pursuant to the Interlocal Agreement between Pine Island and the Sheriff's Department for law enforcement services, to enforce the traffic control (speed limit) signs which have been placed or will be placed on Pierceall Road designed to control speed upon Pierceall Road.


